- c) Indicate the category you are applying for: Junior Researcher (PhD obtained within the last 5 years) or Assistant Researcher.

- Summary of the main activities and results obtained in the last 5 years (max. 5,000 characters, or less for junior researchers).

3. Career Development Plan:

- Description of how the expression of interest aligns with your career goals and future scientific objectives (max. 5,000 characters).

- Define and contextualize the objectives and scientific questions to be addressed, the activities to be carried out, expected results, and how they align with the research themes of UNIDCOM, CETRAD-Europeia, and CIDESD-Europeia. CIDESD-Europeia Description

CIDESD-Europeia is an applied technical-scientific research unit, inter-institutional and multidisciplinary, focusing on Sports Sciences, Health Sciences, Psychology, and Human Development. Based at Universidade Europeia in Lisbon, it is a research hub of CIDESD-Research Center in Sports Sciences, Health Sciences, and Human Development, headquartered at Universidade de Trás-os-Montes e Alto Douro (Vila Real), with 10 institutions in consortium and 133 members, of which 73 are integrated and 60 are collaborators. The unit consists of 3 major research communities: CreativeLab, GERON, and STRONG. CIDESD has a vast national and international network, with bilateral agreements with 10 institutions, 8 cooperation agreements with Higher Education institutions, 32 European institutions, and several in Brazil. It is also a member of international networks linked to academic institutions in North America, Asia, Australia, New Zealand, and Africa. We're looking for a highly motivated Junior Researcher to join the CIDESD-Europeia research team, focusing on Sports Science, Health Sciences, Psychology, and Human Development. The ideal candidate should be interested in exploring the connections between physical exercise, psychological well-being, and individual health, with a focus on behavioral and physiological markers in both educational and high-performance sports settings.



Main goals:

- Develop scientific evidence on the synergies between sports science, mental and physical health, and human development, preferably from a psychophysiological perspective and within educational and/or highperformance sports contexts.
- 2. Create toolkits (i.e., action guides and working methods) based on scientific evidence to promote mental health and human development through physical exercise in educational and/or high-performance sports settings.
- 3. Conduct research-based interventions aimed at spreading best practices in physical exercise that promote mental and physical health and human development in educational settings.
- 4. Conduct research-based interventions focused on applying different behavioral work techniques that promote mental and physical health and scientifically evaluate their impact on performance and well-being in high-performance sports settings.

Requirements:

- Knowledge in Behavioral Sciences (Psychology, Neuroscience, Biology) and Sports Sciences (Human Movement, Physical Education, Sports Training, Sports Management).
- Strong orientation towards multidisciplinary research, particularly in studying humans from a psychobiological perspective and analyzing behavioral, psychological, and physiological indicators.
- Strong focus on applied research and developing evidence-based interventions, creating user-friendly products for the community and various stakeholders.
- Ability to work in collaborative and interdisciplinary environments, connecting academia, industry, and local communities, and collaborating with various stakeholders.

This researcher will contribute to developing new evidence-based knowledge, techniques, and working methods that can be easily shared with the community and stakeholders, promoting health and human development through physical exercise in educational and/or high-performance sports settings.

 - b) Research plan merit (40%): alignment with the goals and activities of the UNIDCOM, CETRAD-Europeia, and CIDESD-Europeia research centers.
- 2. The evaluation will be scored on a scale of 1 to 10.
